NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Directors of the Dublin San Ramon Services District will hold a **Public Hearing on Tuesday, June 16, 2026, at 6 p.m., in the Boardroom at the District Office at 7051 Dublin Boulevard, Dublin, California**, to consider the levy of the Dougherty Valley State Water Project (DVSWP) service charges consisting of a Standby Charge and an Incremental Charge on the Contra Costa County secured property tax roll for fiscal year 2026-2027 for non-governmental parcels. Governmental parcels are charged separately on their water bills and are not subject to the public hearing.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the hearing, the Board will consider the Annual Reports concerning the proposed service charges for fiscal year 2026-2027, consider all written protests, hear all persons interested, consider all comments, if any, and take final action on the levy of the DVSWP service charges on the Contra Costa County secured property tax roll for fiscal year 2026-2027.

The DVSWP service charges shall appear on the 2026–2027 (July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027) secured property tax rolls as summarized below:

Dougherty Valley Standby Charge: **“DSRSD-DOUGHERTY VLY 01-1”**

Dougherty Valley Incremental State Water Project Charge: **“DSRSD-DRTY VLY SWP”**
