

# DRUG DROP-OFF LOCATIONS


Clean out your medicine cabinet and safely dispose of expired and unused drugs. Unless it is specifically stated on the packaging, medicine should not be thrown in the trash or flushed down the drain. Instead, take them to a free drop-off location:

- **Dublin Police Services:** 6361 Clark Ave, open weekdays from 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.
- **San Ramon Police Dept:** 2401 Crow Canyon Rd, open weekdays from 8 a.m. - 6 p.m.
- **Pleasanton Police Dept:** 4833 Bernal Ave, open 24/7

*Take pills out of their original containers and put them into a sealable bag. All pills can be mixed together in one bag. Leave any liquids or creams in their original containers and secure the cap/lid. Black out any personal information and place in a sealable bag.
