COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. The Permittee shall **not discharge** drycleaning process waste, including still oil and separator water to the sanitary sewer.
2. The Permittee shall **not connect** any drycleaning processes to the sanitary sewer.
3. The Permittee shall permanently seal all floor drains, or install berms (physical barriers) to separate drycleaning equipment from the sanitary sewer.
4. The Permittee shall post a sign in the work area indicating that operators are prohibited from discharging process materials and waste to the sanitary sewer.
5. The Permittee is subject to the attached Standard Permit Conditions

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

1. The Permittee shall report to DSRSD – Clean Water Section any changes, permanent or temporary, to the premises or operations that significantly deviate from the terms and conditions under which this permit is granted.
2. The Permittee shall notify DSRSD – Clean Water Section at (925) 875-2322 during business hours, or (925) 846-4565 during non-business hours, immediately upon discovering any accidental spill or slug discharge to the sanitary sewer. Formal written notification describing the circumstances and corrective action must be submitted to the District within 5 days of the occurrence.

RETENTION OF RECORDS

The Permittee shall retain all records pertaining to requirements set forth in this permit including, but not limited to, receipts for off-haul of hazardous and non-hazardous wastes for a minimum of (3) years.

INSPECTIONS

The District may conduct random, unannounced inspections to verify compliance with the conditions of this permit.

TRANSFERABILITY

This permit is non-transferable and valid only to the company and owner to whom it is originally issued. In case of ownership change, please contact the Dublin San Ramon Services District's Clean Water Section at (925) 846-4565.

RENEWAL OF PERMIT

If the licensee wishes to continue the activity regulated by this license, the licensee must submit an application for a new license at least 90 days before the expiration date of this license to:
